

But it is really hard to express that what she was going through in her mind.

Mental trauma is one such theme here used to depict the choice of being alone and spending her time independently. She was becoming dull and lost her interest in her life to live further. Nilima had become more conscious about her own self. She sensed some gradual transformations in the behavior of her husband; it is the real time to witness the true of everything for her. Author had appropriately used several dialogues between Nilima and Nithin to show the difference of opinions and difficulty in accepting the past happening. Being a husband, he is very possessive towards her wife and above all that the patriarchal attitude of male ego which was demonstrated innately through Nithin. Once she was assaulted in front of him, now it is the question of his helpless condition and failed as a masculine power to save his own dear lovable wife.

Escapism is one such theme which was included while dealing with Nithin's moderate separation from Nilima. As the time travels, Nithin was not comfortable as her husband and to be in that relationship for next of his life. It is his drawback in looking into the subject in a deeper sense and to provide her a moral support. Nithin was pictured as a villain and a selfish guy who only thinks about his desires and luxury life and less concerned with human emotions.

Sense of beauty and the concept of aging is symbolically set to display the perishable love life. Once the youth and physical attraction is over, then it is rare to find the immortal and intense love which is beyond the limitations of timely desires of lust. One incident that deeply rooted in the mind of Nithin, he started to maintain a gap with her, as time passes he lost his

She was not the one who planned her life and reason for the downfall. It is all about the dominant society that made her deserted by all the means. She was only the passive receiver to experience the harsh reality.

This short social novel following all these arguments and concepts centered on Nilima gave us a detailed idea about the limitations of the choices in their life and lacking to address the interior struggles and humiliations as double oppressed creatures who were placed low in this system of power structure.
